Colonel Steven A. Mys is the Deputy Commander of the Joint Warfare Analysis Center, Dahlgren, Virginia. He is responsible for directing, organizing, tasking and executing effects-based, precision-targeting and other engagement options, weapons effectiveness analysis and battle/collateral damage assessments for the CJCS and Combatant Commanders to prepare and execute OPLANS. Supervises over 400 civilian, military and contractor personnel in a Joint, classified, state-of-the-art scientific and engineering organization. Directly manages an annual budget of over \$115M.

Colonel Mys was commissioned in November 1990 as a Distinguished Graduate of the Michigan Technological University Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps. He served in numerous flying tours and his staff assignments include the Electronic Systems Center and U. S. Northern Command. Colonel Mys commanded the 343d Reconnaissance Squadron, and prior to his present position served as the Director of Staff for the 55th Wing, Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska.

Colonel Mys is a Command Pilot with more than 3,100 flying hours.
